RESOLUTION  
NO.24/80

The Senate RESOLVED that the Associate membership of the undermentioned Professional Bodies be accepted as sufficient qualification for admission to M.Tech. degree course at the Institute with effect from 1981-82 session:

- a) The Institution of Engineers (India), Calcutta
- b) The Aeronautical Society of India, New Delhi
- c) The Indian Institute of Metals, Calcutta
- d) The Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers, Calcutta

Candidates will be considered for admission only if they satisfy all the conditions given below:

- a) They must have completed all courses of all sections/parts of the examination within 5 years and should have secured a minimum of 60% marks on aggregate in each section/part.
- b) They should be admitted only through CEPA or through an equivalent examination.
- c) The admission of such candidates will be initially confined to their parent disciplines.
