I have noted that we can verify with you if an applicant is a member of Institution. These are applicants for graduate membership of our Institution. In broad times we accept their academic qualifications if they are equivalent to the graduates of the University of Nairobi, or equivalent to the degrees which are accepted by the Council for Engineering Institutions (UK) for the purpose of exemption from the CEI examinations parts 2. I should be grateful if you could let me know which Indian University degrees are accepted for similar purposes by your Institution.

The degrees I am particularly interested in at the moment are those of the University of Kerala and of the University of Poona. Copies of papers for two particular candidates are enclosed i.e. Mr. R. C. Aggarwal (University of Kerala), H. S. Shah (University of Poona).
