Dear Mr. Saini,

Thank you for coming to the office on September 29, 2008 to discuss your work experience with the interview panel. I am pleased to inform you that the committee has exempted you from writing confirmatory examinations and that you are now eligible for Provisional Membership.

The committee determined that you do not have satisfactory engineering experience in a Canadian environment, and has therefore recommended that you gain one year of satisfactory engineering experience under the direct supervision of a professional engineer in a Canadian environment. Direct supervision means that the responsibility for the control and conduct of your engineering work will be assumed by your supervising professional engineer. When you have completed the experience assignment, you are invited to submit your logbook and a letter providing complete details of your additional experience, listing the names and addresses of at least two professional engineers who have detailed knowledge of your work, and requesting that your application be reactivated. Please arrange to have the professional engineers complete the reference form found at <http://www.apeg.bc.ca/reg/docs/referenceform.pdf> and have them send it directly to APEGBC by fax or mail.

I would like to clarify that your application for registration has not been refused. We will continue to review your application after you have successfully completed the requirements explained above.

Should you wish to appeal this decision, please submit a formal letter of appeal, together with a reassessment fee of \$157.50 to the Association within 30 days of receipt of this letter. A copy of the Association's Policy on Reassessment Requests (Appeals) is attached for your information.
